

This exciting new green space has been created on the former Bromborough landfill site. The 37 metre mound created by the landfill has been transformed into a country park that offers unrivalled view across the Mersey to the spectacular Liverpool skyline.

The park has 2.8 miles (4.5km) of paths to walk, jog and cycle. To the north of the site is a lake which is rich in wildlife and is an important area for water birds. This area is next to the Mersey estuary mudflats which is a site of special environmental protection.

Much of the site is still developing, 15,000 new trees have been planted and thousands of wildflowers seeds have been spread. As nature takes a hold the park will mature and develop attractive habitats both for wildlife and visitors.
