Chestnut Trail is a circular route which takes in the stunning woodland of Duke's Wood with views Basingstoke Canal and the flashes. It also takes you to the largest area of heathland in Wellesley Woodlands.

Flashes

You will see one of the three 'flashes' at Wellesley Woodlands - Claycart Flash. When the Basingstoke Canal was dug in the 18th Century, hollows in nearby land filled with water. These little pockets of water act as mini reservoirs for the canal, storing water for when levels are low.
