A quick look

Step by step walking route

- Head from the car park through the main entrance and along the path under the woodland canopy. Look out for blackbirds, chaffinches, nuthatches and tree creepers as you go and listen out for buzzards overhead.
- Once you emerge from the woodland walk through the viewing mounds in front of you and the lady will reveal herself. Keep a watchful eye on the lake to see a grey heron catching its lunch or a tufted duck making its way through the reeds.
- 3. Head back the way you came to the car park.

- follow advice and local signs
















Woodland trail
