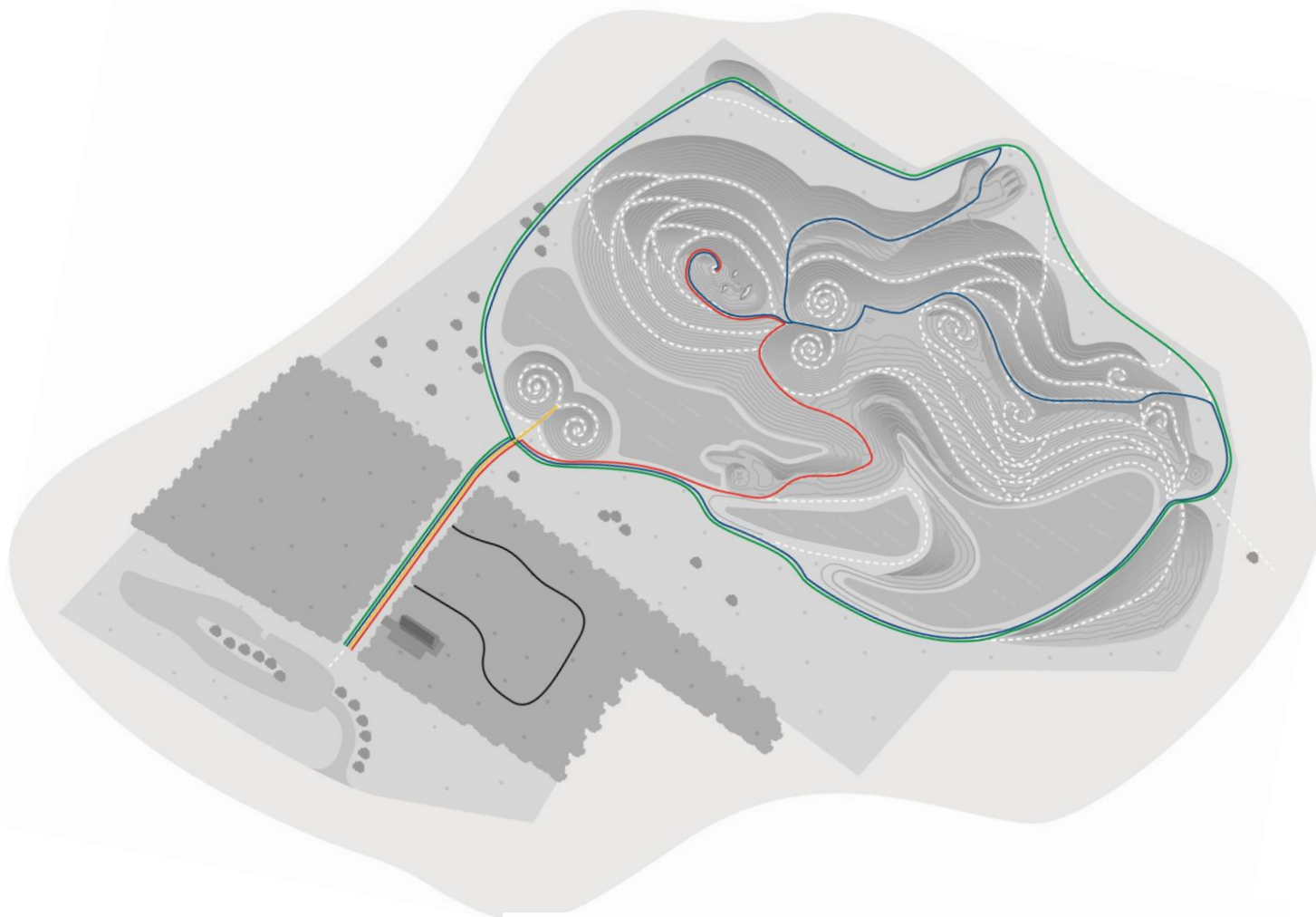

**Opening hours:** Every day dawn until dusk. Visitors Centre open 10am – 4pm

**Toilets:** During Visitor Centre opening hours



**Café:** In Visitors Centre



**Dogs:** To be kept on leads at all times.



**Accessibility:** Disabled parking, well surfaced paths, some flat.

## Round the outside

### Step by step walking route

This walk is 1.6 km long on flat ground and should take approximately 25 minutes. If you feel that you have some energy left and would like to add another lap of around the sculpture route it will add another 1.2km to your walk.

1. Starting at the main entrance in the car park walk through the wood and once you get to the end of the woodland turn right and walk around the lower path all around the edge of the sculpture.
2. Notice the changes in the seasons, taking time to see what flowers are growing up in the meadows and the colour variation of the leaves in the woodland. Look out for bird life on the ponds and the chance of a chick or two come the spring or early summer. When you reach the foot listen out for skylarks singing in the overhead.
3. Once you make it back to the woodland path turn right and head back to the car park.
