

# Nature decorations

Create your own nature decorations from sticks and twigs you have collected on your winter walk!

Create a loop with string to hang from your chosen location.

Green string and gold star details.

Overlapping four sticks of a similar length and gluing or securing in the centre works great too.

Three sticks glued in each corner and wrapped in twine. Decorated with holly and red wool.

## What you need

Collection of sticks  
String, twine and a glue gun  
Nature objects like pine cones, holly leaves, fir and conifer cuttings.  
Wool, and paper stars for decoration.

Make sure you wash your hands afterwards and ask for help from an adult.

Try using smaller sticks and building up to bigger ones, to create a tree shape like this.

## Instructions

1. Create a star or tree shape with equal length sticks on a flat surface.
2. Over lap the sticks and use a glue gun if you have one to glue your design together.  
If you don't have a glue gun, you can also wrap twine/string around the sticks until secure.
3. Once your shape is complete, cover the glue by using twine to wrap around the overlapping sections.
4. Add extra decorations with holly, conifer cuttings and paper stars by using either glue or string/twine to secure.
5. You can wrap colourful string or wool around your shapes to add extra colourful details.
6. Don't forget to add some string so you can hang your creation!
